

The Phelps County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on November 4, 2025, at 9:00 A.M. as per public notice given in the Holdrege Citizen on October 28, 2025, a copy of the proof of publication being on file in the County Clerk’s Office. Availability of the agendas was communicated in the advance notice of the meeting. All of the proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Commissioners Tom Nutt; Matt Gregg; Russ Cruise; Theresa Puls; Rick Streeter; Barb Malm and Dennis Ostgren. were present. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ostgren. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Dennis announced the open meeting law would be in effect and that a copy is posted on the wall.
