The Phelps County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on February 3, 2026, at 9:00 A.M. as per public notice given in the Holdrege Citizen on January 27, 2026, a copy of the proof of publication being on file in the County Clerk's Office. Availability of the agendas was communicated in the advance notice of the meeting. All of the proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Commissioners Tom Nutt; Theresa Puls; Rick Streeter; Matt Gregg; Russ Cruise; Barb Malm and Dennis Ostgren were present. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ostgren.
