The Phelps County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on March 10, 2026, at 9:00 A.M. as per public notice given in the Holdrege Citizen on March 3, 2026, a copy of the proof of publication being on file in the County Clerk's Office. Availability of the agendas was communicated in the advance notice of the meeting. All of the proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Commissioners Tom Nutt; Theresa Puls; Russ Cruise; Matt Gregg; Barb Malm and Dennis Ostgren were present. Rick Streeter absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ostgren. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Nutt moved, seconded by Malm, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Roll call vote was Nutt, yes; Puls, yes; Gregg, yes; Malm, yes; Cruise, yes; Ostgren, yes. Streeter absent. Motion carried.
